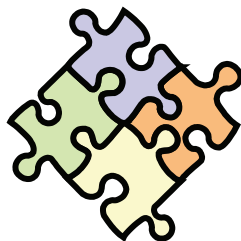

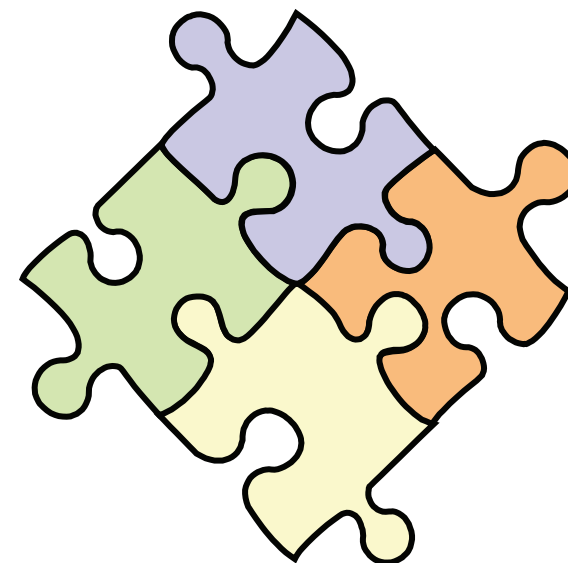

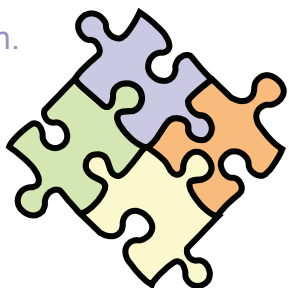


Grimsby Practices in Partnership Service User Guide for Substance Misuse Treatment Services



If you or somebody you know has issues around drug misuse we may be able to help you.

All you need to do is speak to your GP, Nurse or Drug Worker at the surgery you are registered with.



The service offers support to help meet your health and social needs and the easy access to a structured treatment programme.

The team comprises of:

G.P.

The G.P's role includes prescribing of medication, reviewing of treatment programmes and continuous support for any health-wellbeing concerns you may have.

Service Manager

The Service Manager's role includes ensuring the day to day running of the service meets the required standards and guidelines set by The National Treatment Agency and local Drug and Alcohol Action Team. The Service Manager is involved in the treatment clinics and deals with any concerns you may have.

Drug Worker

The Drug Worker's role includes full on-going assessment and care planning, identifying individual goals with the client, guidance and various treatment options with structured support and counselling. Regular motivational drug testing is also an essential part of treatment. The drug worker works alongside all those involved in your care both internal and external to the surgery. If necessary the Drug Worker can advocate on behalf of the client and provide advice, information and leaflets tailored to your needs and choices.

Nurse

The Nurse's role includes full on-going health screening, liaison with the GP should any treatment be required or referral to other health care services. The nurse offers pregnancy testing, contraceptive advice, dietary advice, immunisations, pre and post test counselling for blood born viruses and the promotion of a healthier lifestyle.

Family Support Co-ordinator

The Family Support Co-ordinator's role includes supporting those effected by their own or someone else's substance misuse. The family support co-ordinator provides structured support for families and offers links into support agencies in the community to help maintain or improve health and wellbeing. Providing information on social, leisure, educational, training/ employment opportunities and additional support within the community.
